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1. General

Die FV Hechingen Friedrichstrasse e.V. veranstaltet im April 2022 ihre 3. Auflage des internationalen U10 Jugendturniers im Hechinger Weiherstadion. Das Turnier erstreckt sich auf folgende Termine:

The top priority for the organizers this year is the implementation of hygiene regulations and reducing the incidence of infection to a minimum. For this purpose, a detailed hygiene concept was drawn up for ALL days of the event.


2. basics

All players and visitors are made aware of the generally applicable rules of hygiene and distance and are asked to comply with them:

- The 3G regulation applies to all visitors at the event site
- In principle, the minimum distance (1.5 meters) must be maintained in all areas outside the playing field.
- During training and game breaks, the minimum distance must also be maintained on the field and in the team area
- Physical greeting rituals (e.g. handshakes/hugs) are to be avoided
- Observing the cough and sneeze etiquette (crook of arm or disposable handkerchief) is required
- Advice on washing hands with soap and water (at least 30 seconds) and/or disinfecting hands.
- No spitting or blowing your nose on the field.
- It is strongly recommended to wear mouth and nose protection at all times
- Masks are compulsory in closed rooms. Persons aged 18 and over must continue to wear an FFP2 or comparable mask. A medical mask must be worn outdoors if the distance requirement cannot be maintained permanently

3. Adjustment of terrain structure

In the entrance area there will be both a player entrance (small gate on the left - green) and a visitor entrance (large gate on the right - red). Access for visitors is in turn marked in an entry and exit lane. (picture 1)

Access to the sports center, in front of which the sale takes place, is via the footpath south of the sports center. (Picture 2)

The "exit" from the gastronomy area is formed by the steps to the grandstand. (Picture 3) Thus, there will be no meeting between people who come to buy something and people who have already bought something. In the sales area,

distance markings are glued to the floor.

Disinfectant dispensers will be installed throughout the event site and sufficient soap will be provided at the hand wash basins.

In addition, information signs on the hygiene regulations will be hung up and attached on the premises.

4. spectators

In total, there will be a maximum of 75% occupancy or 2000 spectators plus the participants on the sports grounds!

An online ticket shop will be set up for visitors and spectators of the event from March 20th, 2022, so that there are no long queues. In addition, this ensures that the personal data of all participants is known in advance and can be stored in accordance with the regulations. The tickets are personalized so that a ticket is not transferrable. In addition, every visitor must prove their identity when entering the Weiherstadion by means of a photo ID. The data collected through ticket sales will be stored for 4 weeks.

5. Teams/ players/ managers

All participating players and coaches must be tested. (the official 3G regulation is thus tightened by the organizer) Since the rules applicable to schoolchildren in Germany are no longer in force during the school holidays, each participating club must test its players and supervisors before the start of the trip. The negative test of all players and supervisors must be confirmed or proven to the organizer. Either by showing the daily updated test results or by signing confirmation from the main supervisor.

The players and supervisors are guided to the western area of the Weiherstadion via a separate athletes' entrance. They must remain there throughout the tournament. A changing tent will be made available to the teams in addition to the cabins. In addition, the trainers and supervisors were advised to ensure a minimum distance between their players when changing clothes and using the showers.

6. staff

The organizer's staff present on the respective tournament day will be identified by accreditations. The staff is obliged to wear medical mouth and nose protection during the event, unless they are separated from the spectators by a splash and spit protection or the minimum distance of 1.5 meters can be maintained.

All personnel will be tested on both days of the tournament using rapid antigen tests provided by the organizer.

7. gastronomy

The meals are prepared in the FC Hechingen sports hall. This is also available for guests to use the sanitary facilities.

When entering the sports center, regardless of the purpose, mouth and nose protection (FFP 2) must be worn.

The prepared food is given to the window in a tent set up in front of it (3mx5m). From there it is sold to the guests. Drinks are also sold from this tent.

The checkout area is spatially separated from the serving area for food and drinks. Both at the drinks and food counters, sneeze guard walls will separate staff and guests. The sale takes place cashless by so-called value cards.

8. implementation

8.1 information in advance

The participating clubs will be informed in advance about the hygiene concept and the measures.

Likewise, visitors are already informed about all the modalities and specifications when purchasing tickets online.

The hygiene concept will be published on the association's homepage as well as on the event's Facebook page.

8.2 compliance with the guidelines

A steward/security team will be on site on all event days, whose sole task is to monitor compliance with the measures described in this concept, as well as with the general and sport-related Corona Ordinance.

8.3 sanitary facilities

The disinfectant dispensers set up are regularly refilled.
Sanitary facilities are disinfected every hour (surface disinfection)

9. responsibility

The FV Hechingen with its chairman Nicklas Becker is responsible for the implementation of this hygiene concept on all tournament days.
